



## Edible Education Intern

Green City Market (GCM), a nationally recognized farmers market and local food advocate, seeks an Edible Education Intern for the 2018 Spring Semester (January-April). GCM is looking for an intern who is passionate about educating youth about the food system, nutrition and sustainability. The intern will work with our Club Sprouts program and two Edible Education programs in Chicago schools. The intern must have a reliable mode of transportation and be available to work all market days (Saturday mornings from 8:00am-12:00pm) at our Indoor Market location.

Hours: Approximately 15 hours per week

Compensation: \$500 semester stipend. Class credit can be provided.

As the Edible Education Intern, you will:

- Organize and maintain inventory of edible education supplies
- Provide operational support for our Edible Education programs in Chicago schools, which includes printing lesson plans and assembling materials
- Create short lesson plans about local food, food systems and agriculture for youth that attend the Club Sprouts booth at the GCM Indoor Market
- Design visuals for Edible Education lesson plans
- Collect, organize and report metrics from Club Sprouts and Edible Education programs, including visitors/students, pre and post assessments, quotes, photos and engagements.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Have a positive attitude and creative mindset (artistic skills preferred)
- Be a self-starter
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and Google Suite
- Understanding of sustainable food, cooking, gardening and/or agriculture.
